Denver... 1987, owners Bill McCormick and Doug Schmick opened **McCormick's Fish House & Bar** in Denver's Premier historic district. The twenty square block area, known as Lower Downtown, was nicknamed "LoDo," by Denver Post columnist Dick Krek. The area filled with century-old buildings that have become micro- breweries, residential lofts, offices, antiques stores and art galleries. One of the most distinguished of these buildings is the century-old Oxford Hotel and in it, award winning McCormick's Fish House has established itself as

"Denver's Best Seafood Restaurant"

Exiting from the handcrafted front doors or watching the windows of McCormick's wood-paneled main dining room, patrons view the unique blending of historic and contemporary times. Dodging Oncoming traffic, horse-drawn carriages transport tourists, conventioners and celebrants who are enchanted by the story-telling drivers intent on sharing LoDo's colorful past and who, with sweeping arm gestures, direct their eyes to completed Coors Field home of the Colorado Rockies baseball team.

Next to the main dining room, McCormick's lively bar has become a gathering place for neighborhood residents, business people and local wags. Had one stopped in during the early 1970's they were likely to hear strains of *Blowin' in the Wind* from none other than Peter, Paul and Mary or marvel at a comfortable, youthful John Denver charming onlookers with musical tales of Rocky Mountain High.

Visiting the Cruise Room, across from the main dining room... offers a complete change of pace. Frozen in time since its Art Deco face lift in 1933, this popular bar was fashioned after one of the lounges on the Queen Mary and opened with fanfare the day after prohibition was repealed. Original chrome and neon reflect on the wall panels depicting light-hearted "toasts" from around the world. Step into the Cruise Room today and experience classic cocktails with a generous dose of romance and good times!

Entertaining parties and hosting private functions is also possible at McCormick's with several private dining spaces including the Plum Room, Crystal Room and the Governor's Room. Each room has been carefully restored and provides a classic, warm ambiance for important group gatherings.
